

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 This competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing rules 2010, modified where applicable.
- 2 The decision of the Judges and Organisers is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse any entry without stating a reason.
- 3 In the event of cancellation, the entry fees, less £5 per person will be refunded on receipt of an S.A.E. before 17 April 2010.
- 4 Entry fees can only be refunded after the closing date on production of a Medical or Veterinary Certificate. An administration fee of £5 will be retained.
- 5 There will be a £5 levy for any substitution of horse, rider or combination made after the closing date.
- 6 Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event, nor The Pony Club, or any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators, land, cars/vehicles, their contents and accessories any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any way whatsoever.
- 7 The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the rules and instructions of the organisers and stewards/officials.
- 8 Correct riding attire must be worn at all times when mounted and also for dismounted prizegiving.
- 9 Body protectors are recommended for Show Jumping and compulsory for the cross-country. Competitors wearing body cages MUST leave the key with the Secretary before they go cross country.
- 10 Hats meeting current Pony Club standards must be worn. All hats must be correctly fitted and tagged.
- 11 Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organiser within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £10, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 12 NO STALLIONS except with permission.
- 13 Competitors must present themselves to the steward for tack inspection at least 20 minutes before their dressage time.
- 14 STOP WATCHES may not be used during the cross-country phase.
- 15 MEDICAL ARMBANDS must be worn during the cross-country phase.
- 16 SPURS are only allowed for Pony Club Members who are B test holders and wearing their felts, or those who are carrying a letter form their D.C, giving permission to wear spurs.
